

### Part 3. Cigarette Licenses

#### **Dodge County assumed the responsibility of issuing cigarette licenses in 1998.**

~~303.01. **License Required.** No person shall directly or indirectly keep for retail sale, sell at retail, or otherwise dispose of any cigarette or cigarette wrappers at any place within the limits of the City unless a license therefore shall first have been obtained as provided in this ordinance.~~

~~303.02. **Application and Issuance.** Application for such license shall be made to the city clerk on a form to be supplied by the city. Such application shall state the full name and address of the applicant, the location of the building and the part intended to be used by the applicant under such license, the kind of business conducted at such location, and such other information as may be required by the application form. Upon the filing of the application with the city clerk, it shall be presented to the city council for consideration, and if granted by the council, a license shall be issued by the clerk upon payment of the required fee.~~

~~303.03. **Fee.** The fee for every such license shall be \$12.00 per annum. Every license shall expire on December 31 next after its issuance. For any license issued after January 31 in any year, the fee shall be computed at the rate of \$1.00 for each month or fractional part of the month covered by the license. Licenses shall not be transferable from one person to another.~~

~~303.04. **License Shall be Displayed.** Every such license shall be kept conspicuously posted about the place for which the license is issued and shall be exhibited to any person upon request.~~

~~303.05. **Restrictions.** No license shall be issued except to a person of good moral character. No license shall be issued to an applicant for the sale of cigarettes at any place other than his or her established place of business. No license shall be issued for the sale of cigarettes at more than one place of business. No person shall sell or give away any cigarettes, cigarette wrappers to any person below the age of 18 years. No person shall keep for sale, sell, or dispose of any cigarette containing opium, morphine, Jimson weed, bella donna, strychnia, cocaine, marijuana, or any other deleterious or poisonous drug or controlled substance except nicotine.~~

~~303.06. **Revocation.** Every such license may be revoked by the council for a violation of any provisions of this ordinance if the licensee has been given a reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard.~~

~~303.07. **Penalty.** Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$700.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed 90 days or both.~~
