

APPENDIX I.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF HAYFIELD, DODGE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, RELATING TO CITY PARKS.

The City Council of Hayfield Ordains:

Section 1. All City parks in the City of Hayfield, Dodge County, Minnesota, shall be closed from 11:00 p.m. or one-half hour after the finish of an event approved by the Hayfield City Clerk, whichever is later, to the next succeeding 6:00 a.m.

Section 2. No person shall deface, destroy, diminish or impair the value of public property within any public park in the City of Hayfield, including buildings, structures or trees, shrubs or vegetation located thereon or growing thereon. No person shall litter or cast or allow to remain rubbish or trash of any kind or nature or having any glass containers in or about any city park in the City of Hayfield.

Section 3. No person shall engage in any violent, loud or other disorderly conduct creating or tending to create a breach of the peace.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or park any motor vehicle within the city park except upon the roadways or other designated locations therefore.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person or groups of persons to conduct themselves in any way that shall disturb or adversely affect any other person's peaceful enjoyment of city parks.

Section 6. The City Clerk for the City of Hayfield shall have authority to schedule the use of ball diamonds and picnic facilities in city parks and all groups desiring to use such facilities shall schedule their use with the City Clerk.

Section 7. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and upon conviction therefore may be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00 and shall be subject to removal from the park by Law Enforcement.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication.
