

Part 2. House Moving

802.01. **Permit Required.** No person shall move, haul or transport, any house, building, derrick, or other structure of the height of 16 feet or more, or of a width of 15 feet or more, upon, across, or over any street or alley without first obtaining a permit therefore as provided in the ordinance.

802.02. **Manner of Obtaining Permits.** All applicants for permits to move any of the structures described in Section 802.01 shall be made in writing to the City Clerk, specifying the date and hour the moving is to commence, and the street route over which such structure is to be moved. If it shall be necessary to cut down, move, raise or in any other way interfere with any wires or poles, the application shall state the name of the owner of said wires and poles, the time and place when and where removal of said wires and or cutting, raising, or other interference with said wires will be necessary. A permit shall in all cases upon and appropriate resolution of the City Council; provided however, that in all cases involving the moving of newly constructed houses or buildings, the building inspector shall be authorized to issue the necessary permit when the City Council theretofore by resolution shall have approved the manufacturer, contractor, or mover thereof.

802.03. **Fee for Permit.** Before any permit to move any structure is granted, the applicant therefore shall pay to the City Clerk the sum of \$1.00 which shall be credited to the general fund of the City.

802.04. **Surety Bond Required.** Every person at the time of making application for a permit as provided herein shall execute in favor of the City a good and sufficient surety bond to be approved by the building inspector, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City against any loss by reason of damage to streets or other City property, and saving the City harmless from any damage to private property or damage suit resulting from the failure of such person to comply with the provisions hereof, or from their negligence.

802.05. **Notice to Owners of Wires and Poles.** The City Clerk shall, upon filing of such application, give not less than 10 days written notice to the person owning or operating such wired and poles or to their agents, of the time when, and the place where the removal of the poles, or the cutting, raising or otherwise interfering with the wires and poles will be necessary.

802.06. **Duty of Owners of Wires and Poles.** Every person owning or operating said poles or wires after service of notice, as required in Section 802.05, shall furnish competent workmen or linemen to remove such poles, or raise or cut wires, as may be necessary to facilitate the moving of such structure. The necessary expense which is incurred thereby shall be paid by the holder of the moving permit.

802.07. **Duty of House Movers.** No person engaged in moving any structure defined in Section 810.01 shall raise, cut or in any way interfere with any poles or wires unless the persons or authorities owning or having control of the poles and wires shall neglect or refuse to do so after

having been notified as required in Section 802.05; thereupon, the person or persons engaged in such moving may employ competent and experienced workmen or linemen to perform the necessary work, which shall be done in a careful and workmanlike manner, and the poles and wires shall be promptly replaced, and any damage thereto promptly repaired.

802.08. Violations - Penalty. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$700.00 besides costs, and in default of such payment shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment is made for a period not exceeding 90 days. The penalty imposed by this section shall be in addition to the remedies contained in Section 802.05, 802.06, and 802.07.

802.09. Duty of Building Inspector. The building inspector shall from time to time inspect the progress of the moving of structure and see that same is moved in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

802.10. Red Lantern to be Displayed. Any person moving any structure as herein defined shall display red lanterns thereon in such a manner as to show the extreme height and width thereof from 30 minutes after sunset to 30 minutes before sunrise.
