

ORDINANCE NO. 801.03

**AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF
THE REQUIREMENTS OF
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Hayfield, ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. City Code, Chapter 8 - Building and Housing, Part 1 – Building Codes amended as follows:

OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593:

SECTION 2. Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of **HAYFIELD** opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
