

Hayfield City Council Minutes 2/19/19

Pursuant to due call and notice a regular meeting of the Hayfield City council was held on Tuesday, February 19th 2019. Mayor Rich Fjerstad called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The following members were present: Fjerstad, Siemers, and Subbert. Feist and Anderson were absent.

Motion by Subbert, seconded by Siemers to approve the minutes of the 01/22/19 meeting and to dispense with the reading of the same. Motion carried.

Motion by Subbert, seconded by Siemers to approve pre-paid authorized bills in the amount of \$171,062.35 and to approve payment of current bills on 2/20/19 in the amount of \$38,375.88. Also approved as presented were the January cash flows, fund balances, and bank rec. Motion carried.

Mayor Fjerstad opened the public hearing to rezone parcel 23.100.2520 from C2 to R2. Motion by Subbert, seconded by Siemers to table the vote until the March meeting. Motion carried. Mayor Fjerstad stated that Chad Sonnek does not own the parcel yet and would like to see a purchase agreement in place before passing the resolution.

Deputy Jeff Hoffman gave the January crime report. The council would like to see more consistent enforcement of snow emergency parking violations and more enforcement on unlicensed vehicles on public property. Paul will coordinate with Anderson Auto when cars need to be towed during snow removal times.

Rod Peterson informed the council that the county prosecutor is leaving and going back to Nebraska. He also informed the council that Doctor & Linda Reid have been served notice to demo or fix up the building at 14 West Main Street by March 5th 2019. A demolition order can be issued on March 6th 2019 if the Reids fail to comply with the order.

Paul O'Brien gave the public works report --- removed snow, removed more snow, fixed snow equipment, and removed more snow. ☺ Paul has not contacted the fire marshal to inspect the Hayfield (Maves) Apartments yet.

Greg Rud gave the WWTP update.

Dave Subbert reported that the Field Crest elevator will need repairing in the near future.

Lori will send a letter to commercial snow removal businesses to inform them to not pile snow on the corners or back on to city streets.

Motion by Subbert, seconded by Siemers to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 pm. Motion carried.
